Father award categories: in some cases selection committee may place nominee in more appropriate category. The categories are as defined:

- **Father of the year:** This category is for the father that stands out and goes above and beyond. In the face of adversity the father of the year stands firm and continues to be a supportive and nurturing presence in the lives of his children.
- **Community Dad:** Every kid in the community knows this man. This is the man that reflects what a positive male role-model should be. When you think of this person you envision a person there for young people when they need him.
- **Friendly Dad Organization:** This organization/ company recognize the importance of fathers and the role they play in society and works hard to improve fatherhood efforts.
- **Female Supporter of Responsible Fatherhood:** This award is given to a woman that believes in the role of father. The Female supporter award goes to a woman who is cognizant of the role of fatherhood and works to improve fatherhood efforts when possible.
- **Young Dad Award:** Being a teen-ager is hard and sometimes as a young person, we don't always make the best decision. However, the decision to take care of their responsibility as a parent goes without saying. To be nominated for this award the recipient can be no older than age 22.
